




# Ferrari 360 Modena Install Tips

#### **Important Note:**

Installation tips generated from personal feedback from customers. Results are not guaranteed and are provided as a suggestion only.

## Accessing the Vacuum Solenoid Valves

- RH Vacuum Solenoid Valve easy to connect. Access from just forward of the RH taillight
- LH Vacuum Solenoid Valve somewhat difficult to access. Try removing inside taillight bulb holder. If need more room to access, remove outside bulb holder.
- If removing bulb holders does not provide enough access (you have giant hands), remove the outside taillight assembly, or remove LH rear wheel and splash guard to gain access



## **Potential Controller Module Installation**

Several good locations for installing the controller module. Some recommendations:

- Behind left or right engine bay panels ... secure with cable ties or use adhesive mounting strips / Dual Lock strips
- Area immediately in front of taillight assemblies. Especially on manual transmission cars as there is a large open void on the RH side. On F1 cars, this area is where the F1 pump and fluid reservoir is located.
